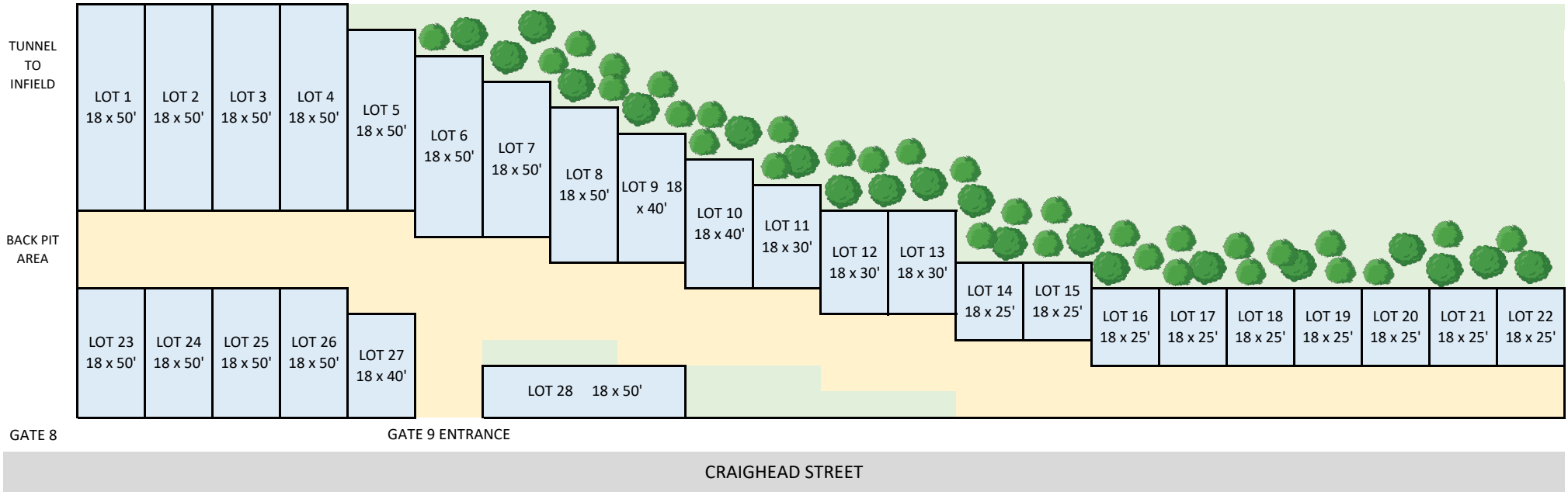

There are no hookups and the entrance to the camping lot is at Gate 9 off of Craighead Street. Camping is \$30 per day or \$75 for the entire weekend.

**FAIRGROUNDS CAMPING RULES**

All guests are required to read and adhere to the following Recreational Vehicle Rules. They are designed to ensure that all guests have a quiet, pleasant, and enjoyable visit.

**Garbage:** Garbage should be in sealed plastic bags and placed in trashcans near your area.

**Pets:** Pets are welcome in the camping area. All pets must be leashed and under physical control of the owner at all times. 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. All children under 18 must be on their site by 9:00 p.m. **Fireworks:** Strictly prohibited for the safety of all campers. **Fire pits/bonfires:** Open fires are prohibited. **Lawful Activities:** Guest are expected to abide by all state, local, and federal laws. **Enforcement:** Failure to follow these rules may result in fines being assessed to your account.
